Manatee County Animal Services to host July 23 free pet vaccination event at Rocky Bluff Library

MANATEE COUNTY, FL (July 15, 2021) – Manatee County Animal Services and District 1 Commissioner James Satcher will host a free pet vaccination, microchip and licensing clinic for Manatee County pet owners on Friday, July 23 from 8 a.m. to noon at Rocky Bluff Library.

Pet owners must register in advance at www.mymanatee.org/petclinic. Dogs must be leashed and non-aggressive. Cats must be in a secure carrier. Pet owners will need to provide a driver's license, or state ID, and a completed clinic waiver.

The free clinics were made possible through a \$10,000 donation from the Manatee Community Foundation.

Vaccines (rabies and distemper)

Microchip (with pet registration)
